BE IT REMEMBERED, That a Regular Hearing of Commissioners Court in and for Burleson County, Texas held in the Regular Meeting place of said Court in the County Courthouse in the City of Caldwell, Texas on the 23rd day of February, 2026 at 9:00 o'clock A. M. with Judge Keith Schroeder, Commissioners Vincent Svec, David Hildebrand and Bobby Urbanosky present and County Clerk- Anna L. Schielack were in attendance when the following business came before Court:
