BE IT REMEMBERED, That a Regular Hearing of Commissioners Court in and for Burleson County, Texas held in the Regular Meeting place of said Court in the County Courthouse in the City of Caldwell, Texas on the 13th day of April, 2026 at 9:00 o'clock A. M. with Judge Keith Schroeder, Commissioners Dwayne Faust, Vincent Svec, David Hildebrand and Bobby Urbanosky present and County Clerk- Anna L. Schielack were in attendance when the following business came before Court:

- 1) Judge Keith Schroeder called the meeting to Order with the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.
- 2) Prayer was given by Reverend Jacob Roach.
- 3) On Public Forum- Brad Oliver spoke to the Court from 9:02 a.m. to 9:03 a.m. introducing himself to the Court and reported that he is a candidate on the City of Caldwell ballot for Mayor.
- 4) Department Reports:
Sheriff's Report – Sheriff Rios reported that the Sheriff's Department has the following openings: 1 in Patrol, 1 Investigator, 2 dispatcher and 2 Jailers. Sheriff Rios also reported that there are 54 inmates in jail. (42 males 12 females) Sheriff reported Chili Fest was cancelled for Saturday, April 11th. Treasurer Stephanie Smith reported that the Time Clock is not working and she has not even been able to fingerprint everyone yet. Raileen Murray reported that cleaned up trash around the Sheriff's Department, and in two week Somerville will have a cleanup, and May 9 for Snook cleanup. Albert Ramirez reported they are looking at a grant program that will help with the schools and children, also they are awaiting their new building for the Health Resource Center downtown on Buck Street. Angie Jones reported that she remapped County Roads 290, 291 and FM 60, and she is waiting on BVCOG to give accepted data back to us.
