BE IT REMEMBERED, That a Regular Hearing of Commissioners Court in and for Burleson County, Texas held in the Regular Meeting place of said Court in the County Courthouse in the City of Caldwell, Texas on the 27th day of April, 2026 at 9:00 o'clock A. M. with Judge Keith Schroeder, Commissioners Dwayne Faust, Vincent Svec, David Hildebrand and Bobby Urbanosky present and County Clerk- Anna L. Schielack were in attendance when the following business came before Court:

- 1) Judge Keith Schroeder called the meeting to Order with the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.
- 2) Prayer was given by Reverend Melvin Dornak.
- 3) On Public Forum-Mayor Janice Easter Spoke to the Court how she appreciated working with Commissioners Court and the Judge while she was Mayor.
- 4) Department Reports:
Sheriff's Report – (See attachments) Chief Deputy Simmons reported that the Sheriff's Department has the following openings: 2 jailers, 1 CID, 3 dispatchers and 1 in patrol. Sheriff Rios also reported that there are 57 inmates in jail (49 males and 8 females). Stephanie Smith thanked the County Officials and Commissioners for working well together. She has a meeting with ENCO with Tyler Technologies, Inc. for getting straight the integration of the time clock. Shawn Edwards reported April is 22 years of Albert Ramirez startup of the Health Resource Center. Jody Tillery reported the tire cleanup went okay this past weekend. Angie Jones reported she is working of DOJ (Department of Justice) and the web for ADA Compliance Requirements. Patty Vychopen our EA (Elections Administrator reported she went from the Primary Election straight into elections with the City and School Elections, reporting that the Election Day for those in Saturday, May 2, 1926, and then will go straight into the Primary Runoff Election with Early Vote being May 18-22 from 7am-7pm at the Courthouse and Election Day for the Primary Runoffs will be Tuesday, May 26, 2026.
