BE IT REMEMBERED, That a Regular Hearing of Commissioners Court in and for Burleson County, Texas held in the Regular Meeting place of said Court in the County Courthouse in the City of Caldwell, Texas on the 22nd day of June, 2026 at 9:00 o'clock A. M. with Judge Keith Schroeder, Commissioners Vincent Svec, David Hildebrand and Bobby Urbanosky present and County Clerk- Anna L. Schielack were in attendance when the following business came before Court:

- 1) Judge Keith Schroeder called the meeting to Order with the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.
- 2) Prayer was given by Pastor DeWet Steyn.
- 3) On Public Forum-from 9:05 a.m. to 9:12 a.m., David Besly with the grant projects reported that Chestnut Road in Cade Lake Estates has been blessed and approved to continue the road project due to the fact the road preparation held up after the rain floods last week. He reported that the bridge on Mallard Road in Beaver Creek should be granted an extension with the grant and GLO (General Land Office) due to the flooding that occurred last week. Aaron Maldonado introduced himself to the Court that he will be inspecting offices and other things for insurance through TAC for the County.
- 4) Department Reports:
Sheriff's Report – Chief Simmons reported that the Sheriff's Department has the following openings: 1 jailer, 3 dispatchers and 1 in patrol. Chief Simmons also reported that there are 55 in jail (46 males and 9 females). Shawn Edward reported that on July 9, 2026, they are partnering with Brazos County Health Department to help do breast cancer screening in both Burleson County Health Resource Center both in Caldwell and Somerville, Texas. Patty Vychopen reported it worked well with elections in the Health Resource Building. Kim and Patty went to election training. She also reported that the moisture due to rains caused plaster to fall from the ceiling between County Clerk's office and Patty's office.
