BE IT REMEMBERED, That a Regular Hearing of Commissioners Court in and for Burleson County, Texas held in the Regular Meeting place of said Court in the County Courthouse in the City of Caldwell, Texas on the 27th day of July, 2026 at 9:00 o'clock A. M. with Judge Keith Schroeder, Commissioners Vincent Svec, David Hildebrand and Bobby Urbanosky present and County Clerk- Anna L. Schielack were in attendance when the following business came before Court:

- 1) Judge Keith Schroeder called the meeting to Order with the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

Sheriff's Report – Sheriff Rios reported that the Sheriff's Department has the following openings: 1 jailer, 3 dispatchers and 1 in patrol. Sheriff Rios also reported that there are 55 in jail (47 males and 8 females). Sgt. Stohler reported they are working on HB 33 mandate.
